### **Project Work Description:**

- Removal and temporary storage of 1,182 large granite monument stones, most weighting 6,000 lbs or more
- Extensive repair to existing concrete substrate in order to prepare a suitable surface to waterproof
- Numbered stone pieces were reset and reinstalled over the new surface
- Extensive measures were taken to protect new waterproofing
- Granite stone was cleaned, repaired and joints were sealed
- After reseeding the project site, a new irrigation system was installed
